Brief Introduction of the Session:

Humans are facing a potentially catastrophic global problem owing to the excessive emission of carbon dioxide (CO_2) annually into the atmosphere. A potential solution to mitigate the effects is to store CO_2 in large porous/fractured reservoirs within the Earth. Fluid mechanics and geomechanics play crucial roles in determining both the feasibility and associated risks of this geological sequestration. The injection of significant volumes of CO_2 into the formation involves many natural processes, such as multi-fluids (CO_2 , brine etc.) flow, convective mixing, reactive transport, and rock deformation and fracturing. Our limited understanding of these processes makes it difficult to improve the CO_2 sequestration efficiency and prevent the CO_2 leakage.

The objective of this minisymposium is to provide a platform for the discussion of all possible aspects of multiphase flow and rock mechanics in geological CO_2 sequestration, including theoretical, experimental, and numerical approaches. This topic will discuss the following issues, but not limited to:

- Multiphase flow in porous/fractured media
- Reactive transport in porous/fractured media
- Convective mixing of CO₂ and brine in porous/fractured media
- · Rock deformation and fracturing when fluid injected
